

What you can do from your ERP

Automate bank account reconciliation. Prior-day transactions post directly into your ERP with auto-match rules.

Send payments — ACH, wires (domestic & international), checks, and virtual cards — with auto-generated remittance emails to vendors.

Set tighter controls. Mitigate risks by eliminating the rekeying of payment data and manual file exports/imports.

How it works

- Install the plug-in. Start in sandbox and connect your ERP to SVB.
 - Map & authenticate. Map your SVB accounts and set up vendor payment information.
- Sync & operate. Data & payment instructions flow automatically both ways between your ERP and SVB accounts. No file uploads needed.
